We would like to invite you to create a project about one of our topics from this half term and bring it into school on the week commencing **Monday 19th May 2025** to show your classmates!

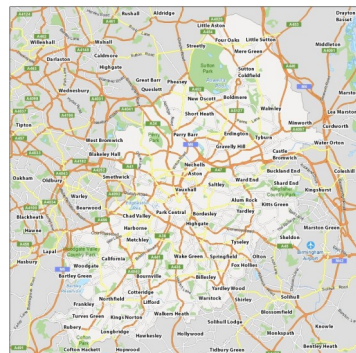
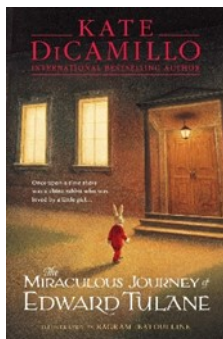
You could create a PowerPoint presentation, an interactive poster, a 3D model or even a comic strip! It is completely your choice how you decide to present your learning.
