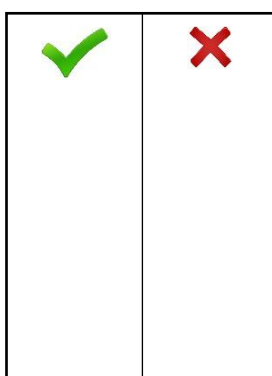

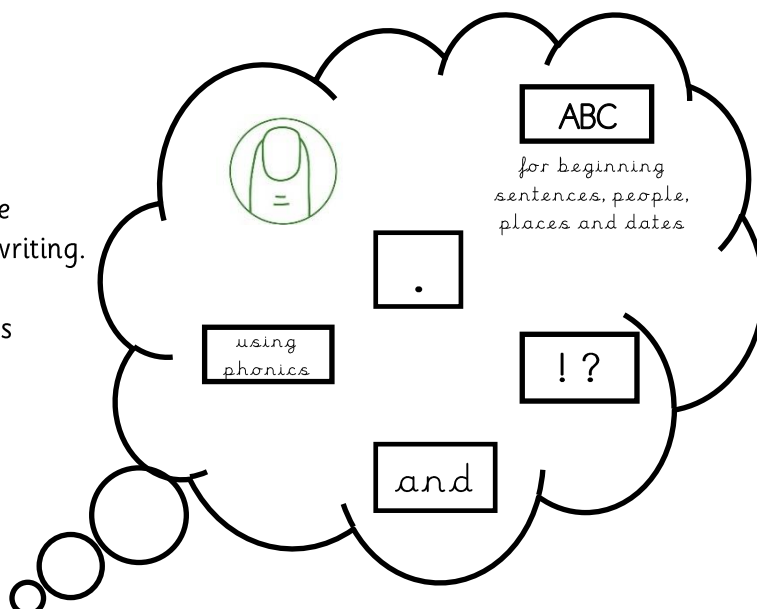
Read the words and sort them into real and nonsense words.

### **Addition and subtraction:**

Complete the workbook and encourage children to always look carefully and check their answers. If they are finding it difficult, encourage them to use practical resources or draw pictorial representations like dots to support.
