

Dear Applicant,

We are absolutely delighted that you are interested in applying for the Head of School position at Boldmere Juniors, which along with our Infant and Nursery school on the same site forms the Federation of Boldmere Schools.

We are fully aware that all schools are different and here is some information to help you decide if our school is suitable for you as we have incredibly high expectations of our school leaders and staff.

Boldmere Junior School is a three-form entry school, with over 360 pupils in attendance. Currently we are also designated as a Teaching School and have been since 2013. The school works side by side with our Infant School, which is a three-form KS1 school with a Nursery class, with over 322 pupils in attendance. We are a large site, which requires careful management and organisation.

As part of our educational provision on our shared school site, we also have an Inclusion Resource Base to support children with ASC who have EHCP's. This is in addition to our pupil admission number and we currently have 15 pupils in attendance, 7 of which are junior children who have timetabled access to mainstream provision as and where possible. The number of pupils attending our Resource Base is planned to increase to 20 pupils in September 2021 and we are excited at the prospect of having additional children at our school that we can cater for effectively. So SEND provision is really important in our setting which we feel it is imperative for you to know.

When it was last inspected, Boldmere Junior School was graded as an 'outstanding' school (Ofsted, 2011) that works relentlessly to try to maintain that judgement. As the outstanding exemption has been removed, we are long overdue an inspection and expect to be inspected in the near future so recent experience of Ofsted would be an advantage.

We are looking to appoint a Head of School with the drive and expertise to help us to maintain our high standards. The successful candidates will be joining an inclusive











school that celebrates diversity and where everyone associated with the pupils are devoted to providing the very best opportunities for all.

Our website will give you a feel for the school but informal visits are welcomed and encouraged. Covid-19 regulations and rules will be explained when you book a visit.
