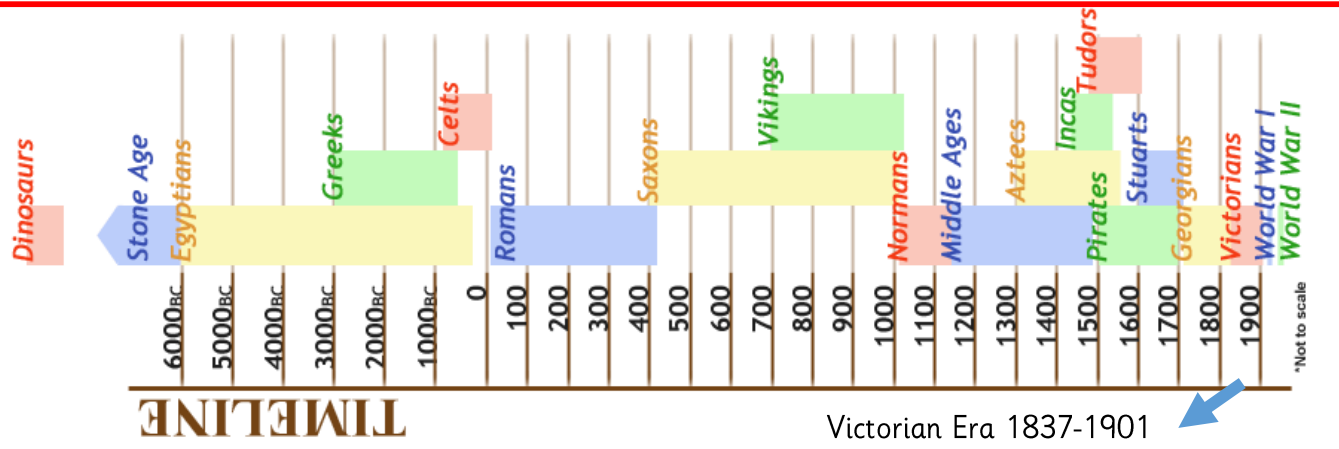

ADDING & SUBTRACTING FRACTIONS EXPLAINED!

$$\frac{3 \times 7}{3 \times 9} - \frac{2 \times 9}{3 \times 9} \rightarrow \frac{3}{27}$$

MULTIPLYING FRACTIONS BY WHOLE NUMBERS

STEP-BY-STEP

$$\frac{2}{7} \times \frac{3}{1} = \frac{2 \times 3}{7 \times 1} = \frac{6}{7}$$

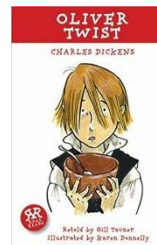

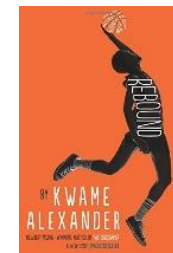

numerator	top number in a fraction
denominator	bottom number in a fraction
equivalent	equal in value, amount, function, meaning
translation	moving a shape
simplifying	no common factors in the numerator and denominator
British Empire	territories all over the world that were controlled by Britain
slums	the squalid part of a city, full of overcrowded houses in poor conditions
workhouse	where people who were too poor to support themselves received food and housing for doing work
mechanisation	the equipping of industry with machines
class	a group of people sharing a similar rank
Conductor	a material which can control the flow of electricity
Insulator	a material that does not allow electricity to pass through.
resistor	a basic electronic component that prevents the flow of electric current.
