Christmas is fast approaching and we would like to give you the dates of special events at the school.

We know how popular school Christmas performances are and as we have limited space we will be allocating two tickets per family for the Reception, Year One and Year Two performances. Admission is by ticket only including the dress rehearsals. We must observe the fire regulations limit on numbers so we will be allocating seats on a first come first served basis. Please complete the attached form to order your tickets and return to school by Friday 1st December. Tickets will be sent home in your child's book bag the following week.



In line with our usual practice, please do not bring camcorders or cameras, including camera phones, into the performances. This is for two reasons. Firstly, we have parents who have asked that their children are not filmed in school. Secondly, filming and photography can be very distracting for the children who are performing. Thank you for your co-operation with this matter.

Your child may leave with you after the 1.45pm performances and you may take siblings home with you. Junior school children cannot be collected early.

Pre-School Children

We are sorry that we cannot accommodate any preschool children at anything other than dress rehearsals. This is partly due to limited space and fire regulations but also because the stars of the show are the children. They put a great deal of effort into learning words and songs so we try to limit the number of distractions during their performance!
