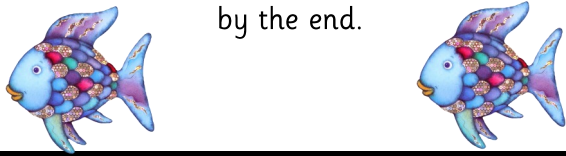


Nursery Home Learning Grid 8/6/20—Topic: Adventures—Week 5—Under the Sea/The Rainbow Fish

These are the activities we will be doing in Nursery this week. Don't forget, these are optional and you might need to adapt them to suit the resources you have at home.

The Rainbow Fish

This weeks main story is 'The Rainbow Fish' by Marcus Pfister. After sharing the online story with your child, discuss how the Rainbow fish was not very kind at the beginning of the story but shared by the end.



Under the Sea dance

Have a go at the Just Dance Kids 'Under the Sea' dance. After having a go, you could think about how different sea creature move and ask your child if they can move like different sea creatures!

Under the Sea Powerpoint

We will be sharing a PowerPoint in Nursery called 'Under the Sea What can you See?' Please find a PDF link on the website for it. You might like to play the I Spy game underneath after!

Floating and Sinking

Have a go at predicting whether items at home will float or sink! You could find a small plastic toy that wants a boat to go sailing in. What would make a good boat? What are the different items made of? E.g. plastic, wood, material, foam.



Celery Printing Fish

Have a go at creating a Rainbow Fish picture printing using a piece of celery! The shape of the celery makes a great scale shape.



Under the Sea I-Spy

In Nursery we are going to have a tray of sea related items e.g. swimming goggles, toy fish, pebble. (If you are struggling to get many items, there is a paper version attached on PDF). You might want to start by naming all the items together first. This is great game to play to support the children with learning to hear initial sounds in words. If your child is not ready for this, you can spy the colours instead. E.g. "I spy something coloured blue."
