We're Going on a Bear Hunt

This is our main story this week, we will retell it a few times, so the children can have a go at repeating the words and actions with us. There is an online link on the link page, with Michael Rosen doing some actions.

You could hide bears around the house and garden for your child to find. They could collect the bears as they find them, then count them. You could also think about ordering the bears from smallest to largest, encouraging your child to use size language e.g. big, small, biggest, smallest, tallest, shortest, tiny, huge, large etc.

Teddy Bears Picnic

We usually celebrate our last week in Nursery with a teddy bears picnic. You could have a teddy bears picnic at home, or at the park. Your child can select their favourite bear to take with them, and they can help you prepare the picnic food.

They might like a roleplay pretend picnic with play food and bears too, encouraging your child to share out food, plates, cups etc for each bear.
