#### Culmington Manor Residential Trip – Year 4 – academic year 2018/19

A letter will be circulated this week to our current year 3 children, who will be in year 4 in September 2018. This is regarding a residential trip which will take place in February 2019. #### <u>Toast</u>

#### Music Fees for Peripatetic Music Lessons as from September 2018

The governors have agreed to increase music fees for the next academic year (2018/19) for brass, violin, woodwind and cello lessons. They will be £80 per term (£240 for the whole year). A reminder that we require a half term's notice should you not wish your child to continue with music lessons.

#### **Medication in School**

A reminder that all medication in school should be GP prescribed and in date. If your child has medication in school for allergies etc. please check that it is in date. All medication may be collected at the end of term for checking and replenishing if necessary, ready for storage in school in September 2018. This also includes inhalers. May we also remind parents that if your child requires medication such as antibiotics/creams etc. for a short period of time, that you collect the bottle/container from the office at the end of the course of treatment, as we are often left with bottle/tubes of medication and this medication needs to be disposed of appropriately.
