New Resources on the School Website:

The illustrator Alex Scheffler has released a digital book for primary school age children, free for anyone to read on screen or print out, about the coronavirus and the measures taken to control it. Published by Nosy Crow, and written by staff within the company, the book has had expert input: Professor Graham Medley of the London School of Hygiene & Tropical Medicine acted as a consultant, and the company also had advice from two head teachers and a child psychologist.

The book answers key questions in simple language appropriate for 5 to 9 year olds:

- What is the coronavirus?
- How do you catch the coronavirus?
- What happens if you catch the coronavirus?
- Why are people worried about catching the coronavirus?
- Is there a cure for the coronavirus?
- Why are some places we normally go to closed?
- What can I do to help?
- What's going to happen next?

A parent who works for the nhs has kindly shared a guide from the Australian government that is simple to use with your children if they have questions about what the virus is (please note that the social distancing guideline is slightly different to ours- 2m not 1.5m)

A template for a time capsule or learning journal for children to document their time in lockdown. This is a template that you may use parts of, refer too to create your own or use fully.

You will find these on the school website under Reception, year one and year two home learning pages. However Junior parents may also find these resources useful.

If your child is eligible for free school meals, you will have received Week 1 FSM vouchers via Parentmail last week. Those eligible will receive Week 2 FSM vouchers via Parentmail so as soon as they are available to school.

Living History- Help your child create a primary source of their own history. A reminder that in our History lessons at school, we often refer to journals and diaries written by people who have lived during particular important events, for example Samuel Pepys during The Great Fire of London.

The current situation, including unprecedented school closures will form part of History for the future. We would love children and their families to keep their own journal to record what lockdown is like for them.

It may be a series of photographs with labels or sentences, documenting activities they have done, it may be a daily diary entry or a video journal. It could be an independent project or something that the whole family could get involved in. We have also linked a resource available on the website.

The journals created during this time will be something very precious to look back on and you never know, children may be referring back to it in their History lesson in years to come!

Bedtime stories read by your teachers every night (Monday to Friday)! Parentmail links will be sent out each day, giving a code to access our private school YouTube channel. Log on each day to hear one of our teachers read a bedtime story!
