General Information

Parking Outside of School and Waiting for your children

A reminder to all our parents/guardians of the need to park their car safely when picking up and dropping off their child/children. Please DO NOT park on the zig zag lines or block the entrance to any of our neighbour's driveways.

We also take this opportunity to remind parents/guardians NOT to allow their children to ride their bicycle or scooter on the school premises at the beginning or the end of the school day as this may cause an accident.

Unfortunately, we have been made aware of damage to a local resident's car. The damage was possibly caused by a child riding either a scooter or bicycle on the pavement. We would ask that parents/guardians please be mindful of this when allowing their child/children to ride on the pavement.
