General Information

Spelling Shed

Thank you for your support in using the Spelling Shed app/website to practise spellings. All accounts should now be fully working. As this is a new system, we are trialling setting a spelling rule for a 2-week cycle. The spellings will be locked for 2 attempts. Once the children have accessed the website and practised twice, they can then try spelling words from Stage 3 (year 3), Stage 4 (year 4) and so on. Children accrue points according to the level and speed at which they spell the words. Well done to 5M – the first class to get on the World Leader board at number 77. If you have any problems, please contact your child's class teacher.

Accelerated Reader

From Monday 5 November 2018 a copy of the parent's guide to Accelerated Reader will be available on the school website. We have recently started to use this reading programme to guide children's reading practice. Every half term your child will access an online assessment (Star Assessment) based on reading comprehension. This gives your child's teacher a range of numbers (book level range) within which your child can choose a book from the library and bring home to read to you/independently. As soon as your child has finished their book, they should come into school, complete an online multiple choice quiz and change books. This is how they will successfully move through the levels. They can change their books as often as they wish – in fact the more the better!

Please continue to encourage your child to pick up any books, comics, newspapers etc and share together at home. At the moment we do not have the Home Connect access, but this is something we will consider in the future. <u>http://www.arbookfind.co.uk/can</u> be used by parents and children to search for books online.
