Reading at the Juniors

We are pleased to be able to tell you that our library is now finished and set up ready for Accelerated Reader. Every child should have already come home with a library book, which they should be reading regularly (minimum of 3 times a week).

On Wednesday this week, every child will come home with a reading record book. Please encourage children to write in the book 3 times a week to share their reading journey. Reading record books will be checked by the teachers regularly.

Our aim is for children to read their library book, come into school to take a quiz, and change their book as often as they like. Every half term the children will carry out an online test to assess their reading and comprehension skills. This is how the range of numbers (that children choose books from) will increase and the books will become more complex.

If you wish to collect your child from the church at the end of the service, please fill in the slip below. All children who are not collected at the end of the service will walk back to school with their teacher and will remain in school until the end of the school day at 3.35 pm.

Bikeability – Year 5

Letters have now been sent out to all year 5 children regarding the above course which will commence on Monday 14 January to Thursday 17 January 2019. Please ensure you read all the information sent out before signing the consent slip. <u>All consent slips must be returned to the school office by Monday 17 December 2018 at 4 pm</u>. We will be unable to receive any more consent slips/applications after that date. If the number of children interested is more than the number of places available, we will pick names 'out of the hat'.

Music Lessons/Payment – Spring term 2019 - £80

A reminder that for those children who receive lessons from the Music Service, payment will be due the first week back in January, in the amount of £80. This will be for the Spring Term (January to April 2019) and must be paid for in advance via ParentPay. We will require a half term's notice should you not wish your child to continue with their music lessons. Music Lessons (Cello, Woodwind, Brass and Violin) will commence the first full week back, week commencing Monday 14 December 2019, unless you have been advised otherwise.

School Meals and Milk Orders – Spring Term 2019

<u>Milk Orders</u> – 12 weeks at £1.05 (21p per carton) = £12.60. There will be no milk during the first week back. Milk will be provided from Monday 14 January 2019 to Friday 12 April 2019.

Roast Wednesday - 13 weeks at £2.30 = £29.90 **Pizza Friday** - 13 weeks at £2.30 = £29.90

If you wish to order Roast Wednesday and Pizza Friday meals for the term, the cost will be £59.80.

Dinner Money for the half term (January 2019 to February 2019)

If you wish your child to receive a school meal each day and would like to pay for the half term, the amount will be £66.70.

Please note that school meals are £2.30 per day = £11.50 per week. All meals must be paid for in advance. We will be unable to provide any child with a school meal until we have received payment. Please ensure that your ParentPay account is in credit.

Should you wish your child's school meal arrangements to change (school meals to sandwiches and vice versa), please give two weeks' notice to the school office. You must ensure that you advise the school office as well as making your payment on ParentPay.

If you think your child may be eligible for free school meals, please contact the school office for more information.

Dinner Money Debts for this term. If your child has had a school meal during this term, please check your ParentPay account to be sure that you have cleared any debts before we break up for the Christmas holidays. If you wish your child to have a school meal next term, please ensure you make your payment **in advance.** Thank you.
