General Information

Medical Information

A reminder that any medication brought into school, should be handed over to the school office for safe-keeping. Parents/Guardians must fill in a medical form regarding administration of the medication. Please DO NOT send your child into school with tablets/medication to keep in their bag/desk.

Please also ensure the school office is up to date with any changes in your child's medical needs etc. *If your child uses an inhaler, please ensure it is in school.*

Previously Looked After Children

If your child was 'previously looked after' then school may be able to apply for some additional funding to support your child in school. A previously looked after child is one who has left care through one of the following routes:2

- Subject to an Adoption Order
- Special Guardianship Order
- Child Arrangement Order (specific to residency-living with)

If you feel that your child meets the above criteria, and is therefore eligible for the additional support, please contact Mrs Jones who will be able to look into this further for you.

<u>Bikeability – Year 5</u>

A reminder that the Bikeability course will take place on Monday 14 January and Tuesday 15 January 2018. We confirm that this course will now be run over two days and NOT four days as originally advised. Letters were sent out confirming places at the end of last term. Unfortunately, not all children were offered a place as the number of children interested in taking part in the course exceeded the number of places available. Please ensure your child brings their cycle, helmet, warm clothing etc. into school on these days.

<u>Clubs – Spring Term 2019</u>

Information regarding the clubs was sent out at the end of last term, which included:

Lunchtime tennis – years 3, 4, 5 and 6 – letters were sent out to all children in school Netball – years 4, 5 and 6 – please ask your child to contact Miss Jackson if they would like to take part.

Jewellery and Craft Club – years 4 – letters were sent out to all children in year 4. Karate – letters were sent out to the existing children attending the club. We may have some spaces available. Please contact the school office if you would like more information or if you would like your child's name to be put on a waiting list. Paper copies of the above letters were sent out to each child. We do have spare copies available in the school office. If you are interested in your child taking part in any of the above after school or lunchtime clubs, please return your consent slip to the school office and make your payment on ParentPay.

Music Lessons/Payment – Spring term 2019 - £80

A reminder that for those children who receive lessons from the Music Service, payment will be due the first week back in January, in the amount of £80. This will be for the Spring Term (January to April 2019) and must be paid for in advance via ParentPay. We will require a half term's notice should you not wish your child to continue with their music lessons. Music Lessons (Cello, Woodwind, Brass and Violin) will commence the first full week back, week commencing Monday 14 January 2019, unless you have been advised otherwise.

School Meals and Milk Orders – Spring Term 2019

<u>Milk Orders</u> – 12 weeks at £1.05 (21p per carton) = £12.60. There will be no milk during the first week back. Milk will be provided from Monday 14 January 2019 to Friday 12 April 2019. You are now able to make your payment via ParentPay.

<u>Roast Wednesday</u> - 13 weeks at £2.30 = £29.90 <u>**Pizza Friday**</u> - 13 weeks at £2.30 = £29.90

If you wish to order Roast Wednesday and Pizza Friday meals for the term, the cost will be $\pounds 59.80$.

Dinner Money for the half term (January 2019 to February 2019)

If you wish your child to receive a school meal each day and would like to pay for the half term, the amount will be £66.70.

Please note that school meals are ± 2.30 per day = ± 11.50 per week. All meals must be paid for in advance. We will be unable to provide any child with a school meal until we have received payment. Please ensure that your ParentPay account is in credit.

Should you wish your child's school meal arrangements to change (school meals to sandwiches and vice versa), please give two weeks' notice to the school office. You must ensure that you advise the school office as well as making your payment on ParentPay.

Dinner Money Debts for this term. If your child has had a school meal during this term, please check your ParentPay account to be sure that you have cleared any debts before we break up for the Christmas holidays. If you wish your child to have a school meal next term, please ensure you make your payment **in advance.** Thank you.
