#### **Square Peg Foundation - Autism Awareness Sessions.**

### Tuesday 28th January (Y5 and 6) and Wednesday 29th January (Y3 and 4)

Next week, we are very lucky to be visited in school by The Square Peg Foundation. The Square Peg Foundation are a local charity (registration 1185040) who have funding available to deliver Autism Awareness Training to school children. They have already delivered training across schools in Birmingham as part of the Diversity Day Workshops and we are told that the training has been very well received by both children and staff. The sessions are tailored to the children's age and are by interactive powerpoint, which they find the children enjoy. The basis of the presentations are very much around difference and that it is okay to be different. Children are involved in the presentation by asking questions and encouraging the children to share their experiences. The sessions very much demonstrate how difference does not stop people from becoming successful. They also show what it is like for a child if they have a sensory overload and what we can do to prevent this from happening.
