School Uniform Grant Applications 2019 – Advance Information

During week commencing Monday 18 March 2019, we will have a supply of the School Uniform Grant Application forms for 2019 in the school office. For eligibility, you must be a resident of the former Borough of Sutton Coldfield, as set by the 1974 boundary. This includes Sutton Mere Green, Sutton Four Oaks, Sutton Vesey, Sutton Wylde Green, Sutton Trinity, Sutton Roughley, Sutton Reddicap and parts of Sutton Warmley and Minworth. Other criteria to be considered regarding receipt of benefits, will be listed on the form. If you would like a copy of the form when they become available, please contact the school office so we can record your interest. Completed forms must be returned to the school office by Friday 29 March 2019.

Dinner Money for next half term

A reminder that dinner money is £11.50 per week (£2.30 per day), payable in advance of receipt of any meal, via ParentPay. If your child has a school meal each day and you would like to pay for the half term (February to April 2019) the cost is £80.50.

Milk – we have some children who are not collecting their milk at morning break time. We remind the children on a regular basis to do so. If you have ordered milk for this term (January to April 2019), please remind them to collect their milk carton from the kitchen at morning break time.
