<u>Local Election – Thursday 7 May 2020 – School OPEN</u> <u>Schools are NOT a Polling Station</u>

We are delighted to inform you that we have managed to make alternative arrangements with the elections office, so that the schools will not be closed for the upcoming elections on May 7th 2020. The schools will remain open and our training room located centrally between the two schools will be the venue used for polling purposes. We have met with representatives from the elections office who visited the school and confirmed that the training room was a suitable venue. We demonstrated that we could effectively safeguard the children, so that school can remain open as usual. **Therefore, May 7th 2020 will be a normal school day**!

General Information

School Attendance

As a school, we monitor children's attendance throughout the year and particularly those children whose attendance falls below 95%. This equates to 9 days of absence, which is approximately two weeks, which is equivalent to 50 lessons missed.

We appreciate that there are instances, due to illness or important medical appointments, where a child will be absent from school. However, we would ask that if you are making a non-urgent medical appointment, e.g. a dental check up for your child, you do so out of school hours or during the school holidays, where possible.

We also ask that parents/guardians advise the school office on the first day of their child's absence, preferably before 10.30 am and follow up each absence by sending into the school office a copy of a letter and/or medical appointment letter/card.

We will continue to monitor attendance during the remainder of this term and work with parents/guardians to improve attendance where necessary.

We take this opportunity to remind you that any holiday taken in term time will be recorded as unauthorised. Should you require a 'leave in term time for exceptional circumstances form' please collect from the school office.
