## Music Fees for Spring Term 2020 – January to April 2020 - £80

FAO parents/guardians of children who receive music lessons from the Music Service. As you are aware, music fees are £240 per academic year, which equates to £80 per term (Autumn term, Spring term and Summer term). This is a reminder that we are outstanding with music fees for this term. Some parents/guardians have paid £40 for the full term in the amount of £80. However, some parents/guardians have paid £40 for the first half of the term (January to February 2020) and are now owing £40 for the remainder of this term up to Easter. These parents/guardians will have received a reminder letter last week. We would ask that you please check your ParentPay account to be sure that you are up to date with payment. The school has to make a financial commitment to the Music Service in advance of receipt of lessons. We would remind parents/guardians that we require a half term's notice in advance should you no longer wish your child to continue with their lessons.


#### Attendance for last week
