General Information

School Reports

We would like to inform you that your child's report will be presented slightly different than in previous years. Our previous mechanism for report writing was carried out through an IT system called 'School Pupil Tracker Online' (SPTO). Unfortunately, this system is no longer an option for report writing, as SPTO shut this system down at the end of May 2019.

We have, therefore, formatted a new report template and look forward to circulating your child's report in due course.

Children in years 3, 4 and 5 will receive their reports on Friday 5 July and year 6 will receive their reports on Tuesday 9 July, when the KS2 results have been received and recorded.

Water Bottles

Please ensure your child brings a water bottle with them each day, which they may re-fill in school. All water bottles, lunch boxes, uniform clothing etc. must be named.

Year 6 Trip to the cinema to see Aladdin – Thursday 13 June 2019

A reminder that year 6 will be walking down to the cinema in Sutton Coldfield with staff on Thursday morning. A separate letter was sent home last week asking for parental consent and a voluntary donation of £4.00 per child, payable via ParentPay. **PLEASE ENSURE YOU SEND IN YOUR CONSENT SLIP. Your child will be unable to attend, if we have not received your consent slip.** Please ensure your child has their coat in school with them on that day.

Year 5's Inspire Afternoon will take place this Thursday at 2.00 pm. A separate letter was sent out last week inviting parents/guardians to attend.

Upper School (yrs 5 and 6) Sports Day – Thursday 27 June 2019 at 9.30 am to 11 am

Year 6 Transition Day – Wednesday 3 July 2019

A reminder that children in year 6 will be visiting their secondary schools on Wednesday 3 July 2019 (unless otherwise advised). They will not come into Boldmere Junior School on that day, but will go direct to their new secondary school. They must wear their Boldmere Junior School uniform. For more details, please ensure you contact your child's secondary school direct or visit their website. ***If your child is not taking part in the transition day, they must come into Boldmere Junior School as normal.***

Parents/guardians are invited to attend lower school sports day (years 3 and 4), which will take place on the junior school field at 9.30 am until approx. 10.30 am (weather permitting). Parents/guardians of children in year 6 are invited to attend their school production of Aladdin. The performances will take place on:

Parents/guardians will be allocated **two tickets per performance** and these will be sent home via your child nearer the event.

A bowling trip has been organised for year 6 children on Monday 15 July 2019 at Tamworth. A letter has been sent out to all year 6 children this week giving full details. We will require your consent for this trip. **Please ensure you return the consent slip.** This trip is being subsidised, however, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £11 via ParentPay. There will be a buffet lunch meal included in the cost, so there is no need to provide your child with a packed lunch on this day.

Year 6 Leavers' Disco – After school – 3.45 pm - Thursday 18 July 2019

Year 6 teachers have organised an after school disco for Thursday 18 July 2019. Children will stay in school at the end of the school day and will be offered a pizza tea and disco, before they then walk up to the church for the Leavers' Assembly (see details below). Year 6 Leaver's Assembly – St Michael's Church – Thursday 18 July 2019

Parents/guardians of children in year 6 are invited to attend the above assembly, which will take place at St Michael's Church on 18 July 2019 at 6 pm. This will last approximately one hour. Parents/guardians are invited to Parents Evening on Thursday 11 July 2019 from 4-6 pm. This is a drop in session (no appointment necessary) and is an opportunity to chat to your child's class teacher and meet their new teacher for the next academic year.
