St Michael's Church Hall, Boldmere

The curate of St Michael's church has asked that we include the following in our newsletter:

'We run a Place of Welcome on Wednesday mornings from 9 am until 11.30 am, at St Michael's church hall, Boldmere. We offer FREE tea, coffee, squash and biscuits or toast and jam, along with a friendly atmosphere and local information.

At this venue, we have a **Real Junk Food Boutique**, which offers food and other products collected from the supermarkets that is perfectly useable but cannot be sold in store and would otherwise be sent to landfills. These products are on sale on a pay-as-you-feel basis. The money collected then goes back to The Real Junk Food Project, Birmingham, to help provide for other areas of the city.

We also sell **second hand school uniforms at 50p/item**. Again these items are perfectly useable and this is better than filling landfills with things that can be reused.

Also, at this time and venue, we have a relaxed, all-age communion service, with no obligation to stay throughout the service.
