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year. Please ensure your child has their swimming kit with them in school each Tuesday morning. Girls should wear one-piece swimming costumes and boys should wear swimming trunks NOT long shorts. All long hair must be tied back.

Music Lessons

Due to year 6 SATs taking place in school this week, there have been no violin lessons/piano lessons today. All other music lessons (which take place in the afternoon) will continue this week. As stated in our music contract (peripatetic music lessons – brass, violin, woodwind and cello), we guarantee a minimum of 25 lessons per academic year.

If you have not yet paid your music fees for this term (Summer Term 2018), please do so asap and check your ParentPay account – the total amount for the whole academic year is £75 x 3 (Autumn, Spring and Summer) = £225.00. If your account indicates you have paid more than this for the academic year, we will refund you or carry over the amount to the next academic year. Please contact the school office if you wish to discuss.

France Trip - 2018

A reminder that the final payment for France should be made by Thursday 24 May 2018. The total cost of this trip is £435.00. Please check your ParentPay account to be sure that you are up to date with payments and contact the school office if you wish to discuss. By now we should have received all completed passport forms and photographs, as requested. You will need to apply for a Health Insurance Card which you can do online, free of charge. Please do not send in these cards until we ask you to do so.

Water Bottles

We still have a number of children who do not bring water bottles to school. Please ensure that your child has a water bottle in school which is named. They will be able to re-fill their water bottle during the school day.

Lost Property

A named lunch box has gone missing in school. It is described as a square black lunchbox with a stripe (Smash). It belongs to a child in 5F. If anyone has seen this lunchbox in school, please bring to the office. We would also ask that if your child has a similar looking lunchbox to this, that you check it has your child's name on.
