# **General Information**

#### **School Attendance**

In an attempt to improve our school attendance and lateness record, we take this opportunity to remind our parents/guardians of the importance of your child's attendance at school.

As you are aware, the school does not grant any leave of absence during term time <u>unless</u> there are exceptional circumstances. We ask parents/guardians to put in writing any request for leave during term time to the Head of School (Mrs Silverwood). This should be done, giving two weeks' notice. It is also possible for you to obtain a copy of the 'Leave of Absence due to Exceptional Circumstances' form from the school office.

Birmingham City Council – 'Leave in Term Time (pupils) guidance notes for schools' emphasizes the importance of attendance at school and states that 'pupils with 85% or less attendance between September and the Easter holidays are counted as persistent absentees whether their absence is authorised or not and that those pupils whose attendance is less than 95% for the academic year is shown to compromise pupil attainment.'

If your child is absent from school due to illness, please contact the school office by 10.30 am on the first day of their absence. If your child has a medical appointment, please ensure the office know in advance. If you are collecting your child from school before the end of the school day for an appointment, it is important that the school office and your child's class teacher know in advance.

#### **School Lateness**

With regard to the start of the school day, it is possible for your child to arrive in school at 8.45 am. However, they must be in school by 8.55 am in time for registration, otherwise they will receive a 'late' mark in the register. We appreciate that there may be an occasion when you are unable to ensure that your child arrives on time and on this occasion, we ask that you contact the school office to let them know when your child will be arriving. However, we do continue to monitor those children who arrive in school late on a regular basis. It is important that children are in school for registration as this is a time when important information is relayed to children regarding the school day.

We celebrate pupil attendance in school in a variety of ways. On a weekly basis, the class with the highest attendance percentage is recorded in our newsletter and celebrated in our celebration assembly, we celebrate individual pupils who have achieved 100% attendance each term and at the end of the academic year.

We thank all our parents/guardians for their support in ensuring that their child attends school on a regular basis and on time.

## Dinner Money and Milk Money for this half term/term

Dinner money for this term up to <u>February half term = £65.25 (£11.25 per week)</u>. If you would like your child to have a meal, please ensure that you have paid via ParentPay in <u>advance and that you are in credit for that week</u>.

Roast Wednesday meals for the whole term up to Easter = £24.75 Pizza Friday meals for the whole term up to Easter = £22.50 Both RW and PF meals for the whole term up to Easter = £47.25

A reminder that the price of <u>milk has risen to 22p per carton</u>. The cost for the WHOLE term up to Easter will be  $\underline{\$10.78}$ . Closing date for receipt of your order and payment is Friday 12 January. Please note that milk orders will NOT commence until week beginning Monday 15 January 2018.

Please note, we sent out a letter to all our parents/guardians before Christmas regarding the implementation of <u>a strict debt policy</u> relating to our school meal service. If you have not received a copy of the letter, please contact the school office. <u>All school meals must be paid</u> for in advance.
