Parents/guardians are invited to attend year 5 Inspire Morning which will take place on Thursday 14 June 2018. Full details regarding times and format will be sent out soon.

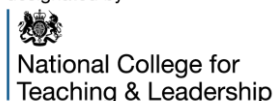
Sports Days – Confirming times - 9.15 am to 11 am
