#### **Scooters/Cycles on School Premises**

May we remind all parents/guardians that no scooters or cycles should be ridden on the school premises. We are aware of a number of children, particularly young children, riding their scooter/cycle on the premises at the beginning and end of the school day. The pathways at the infant and junior school, including the waiting area at the front of junior school can be very busy with many adults and young children. Riding of cycles/scooters in these areas is very dangerous and may lead to accidents. Unfortunately, an accident was reported to the junior school office last week, where both a parent and a child were injured.
