BOLDMERE INFANT AND NURSERY SCHOOL

Boldmere Infant School's Nursery class is state funded and managed by The Federation of Boldmere Schools' governing body. As such it is part of our school.

One full time teacher and two full-time teaching assistants make up the Nursery team.

The Nursery offers part-time places for 52 children, 26 in the morning and 26 in the afternoon. There are no full-time places. Sessions are three hours in duration in line with government policy.

Parents are asked to express a morning/afternoon preference and we will endeavour to accommodate requests.

Morning sessions are 8.30am —11.30am and afternoon sessions are 12.30pm —3.30pm.

In early spring, places are offered, according to the governors' Admissions policy. When there are more applications than there are places, places will be offered using the following criteria:

- looked after or previously looked after children
- siblings (Boldmere Infant and Junior schools)
- distance from school

Children will be introduced into the Nursery in small groups to ensure that they feel secure and happy when starting school life.

Together Nursery and Reception form 'The Foundation Stage'.

Children do not automatically get a place in our infant school. Parents must apply for a Reception place in the same way as other parents.



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
