Reception had a visit from a local farmer who introduced pupils to her livestock and told them all about her job.

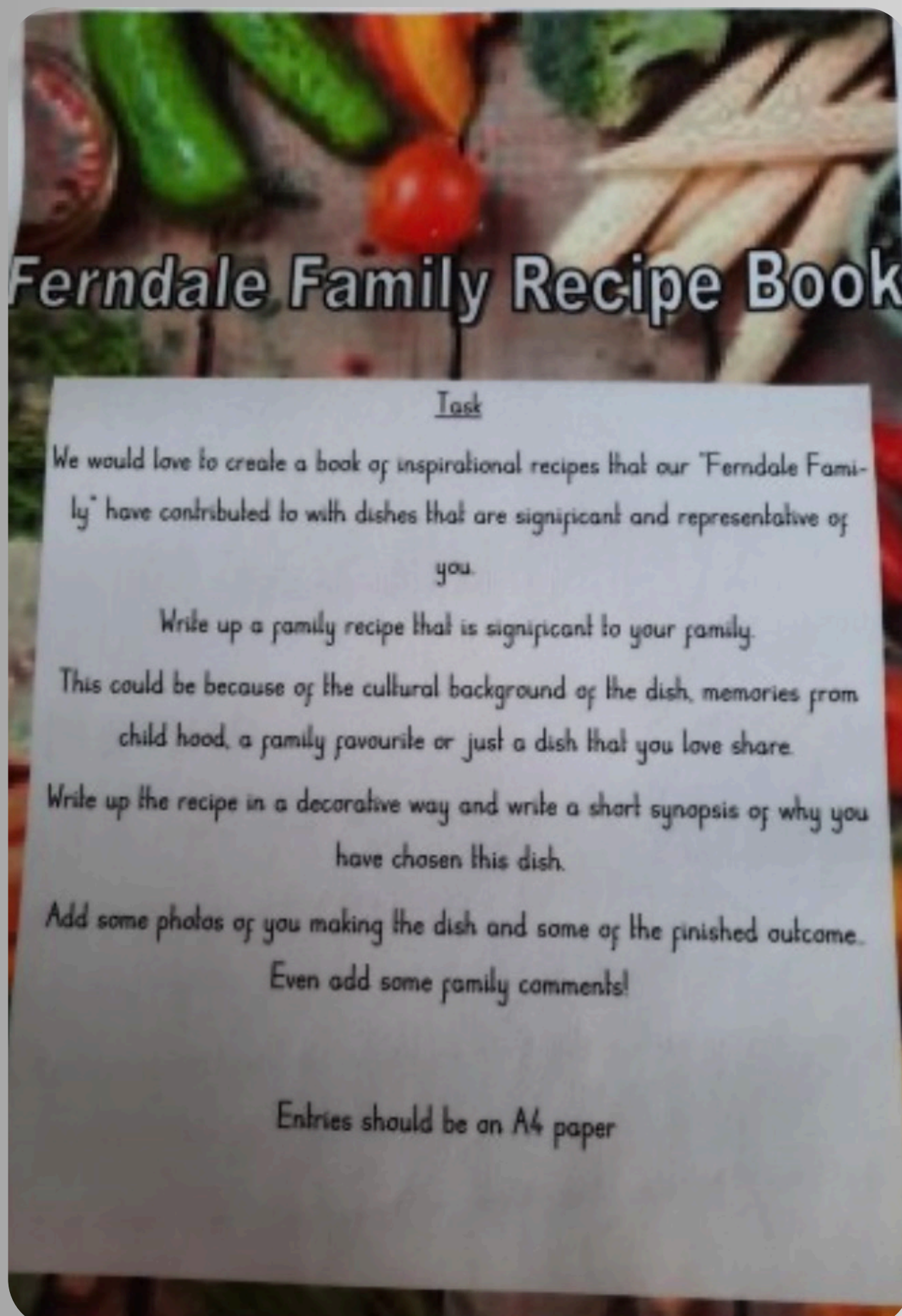
