Topic progression:

Topics are ordered in accordance to their chronology dependent on their period in history. Thus, ancient history is mostly chronological, pre 1066 is ordered chronologically etc. This support the children in their understanding of chronological knowledge as they are able to review previous learning from past year groups about different time periods in history and understand where periods of history sit in correlation to one another.
