Year 6 – Routines and Expectations



First thing in the morning - you will see us:

- entering the playground on time and talking to our friends until the doors are open;
- waiting for an adult to direct us into school;
- quietly walking along the corridor in single file;
- walking up the stairs on the left-hand side;
- entering our classroom quietly and putting our belonging on our pegs and our water bottle next to us on the floor;
- organising our equipment and resources so we are ready to learn;
- sitting down quickly and completing our morning activities.

At playtime - you will see us:

- tidying up after our lesson and putting things away;
- eating a healthy snack and a drink at our desks;
- putting any rubbish in the bin;
- leaving the classroom quietly when an adult directs us;
- using the toilet if needed;
- playing respectfully with our friends.

After playtime and lunchtime – you will see us:

- quickly and quietly lining up in a straight line, facing the front;
- waiting for an adult to direct us into school;
- quietly walking along the corridor in single file;
- walking up the stairs on the left-hand side;
- entering our classroom quietly and putting our coats on our pegs;
- having a quick drink, if needed, and sitting down ready to start next lesson.

<u>At home time – you will see us:</u>

- tidying up at the end of the lesson and putting things away;
- waiting until we are asked and then collecting out things and standing behind our chairs;
- lining up when asked, quickly and quietly;
- sensibly walking downstairs on the left-hand side and along the corridor;
- letting staff know that the person who is collecting us is here or that we are leaving on our own, if we have permission;
- leaving school promptly and calmly.

<u>When we line up – you will see us:</u>

- standing in a straight line;
- facing the front;
- being quiet and not talking;
- walking on the left.
