TERMS OF REFERENCE GOVERNORS' ETHOS COMMITTEE

Membership of the Committee: The Committee is to be made up of 5 members of the governing board, including the Headteacher, plus the Worship Leaders.

Quorum: 3 governing board members of the committee.

Attendees: Other members of the school community may be invited to attend for specific reasons as deemed necessary by the committee membership

Meetings: The Committee will meet, at least, once a term. Meetings will be during the school day and will be minuted by one of the members and submitted to the full governing board.

Responsibilities: The main function of the Committee is to monitor and evaluate the Christian ethos of the school to ensure fulfilment of the SIAMS standards.

Terms of Reference:

- To review the provision and development of collective worship.
- To review the provision and development of Religious Education.
- To review the development of the Christian distinctiveness of the school
- To monitor and take forward the SIAMS action plan.
- To contribute to the strategic planning processes of the school, including the setting of annual school priorities relating to the church school ethos.
- To maintain and enhance school links with the local community.
- To support the development of pupil engagement. The Committee will hear regularly from the Worship Leaders as representatives of the pupils.
