Closing for Christmas holidays:

You may have seen some news reports this week about schools closing a day early for the Christmas holiday on Thursday 17th December. I can confirm that we will still be closing on Friday 18th December at 2 p.m.

We need to try to avoid the whole school leaving at the same time so if you would normally collect your child at 3 pm, please collect them at 1:30 pm. If you normally collect at 3:15 pm, please collect at 1:45 pm and if you usually collect at **3:30 pm**, please collect at **2 pm**.

Year 6 will be released at 2 pm and may walk home if they have your permission.

Assessment/Catch-up Curriculum:

Over the past week, the class teachers have been assessing the pupils progress in English and Maths so that we can identify target groups for next term. In January, we will send home an individual pupil assessment report for the key areas of Maths, Reading and Writing so you can see if your child is on track to achieve age related expectations by the end of the year.

In the Spring term, our focus will be on accelerating progress in these key areas to try to get all pupils' learning back on track after lockdown.

The focus in the first half-term will be on spelling. In week 1 each teacher will give their pupils a list of words to learn, which will be a mixture of common words and words identified as being relevant for their year group or their ability. They will learn these gradually over the half-term and then we will hold a sponsored spell event just before half-term. This will be a way for pupils to challenge themselves; to improve their spelling and also a way to fund-raise for school.

We are also going to run an after-school booster club once a week, from 3:30-4:30 pm, where teachers will work with small groups of pupils on key skills. The class teachers will be inviting certain pupils to attend the sessions. If your child is invited, I strongly recommend that they attend. We will provide refreshments and aim to make the sessions fun!

For most year groups, this will be Thursday. Year 5 to be confirmed.

Community Event - Santa Tour:

We're delighted to announce that despite the pandemic, Santa and Mrs Claus have agreed to take time out from their busy schedule to visit Knott End and Preesall.

On Saturday 12 December 2020 the merry pair, their 'reindeer' and elves will tour the villages bringing some well needed festive cheer.

Their tour will start at 1530 hrs from the Bourne Arms, Knott End taking in the Esplanade (15:45), down Lancaster Road to Park Lane (16:00 – 16:15), up to Fordstone Avenue (16:15), around the Crescent (16:30), back up Sandy Lane (16:30 16:45), right onto Pilling Lane (17:15 – 17:30), left at the roundabout and up Grasmere Road (17:30 – 17:45), back along Lancaster Road to Hackensall Road (18:15), turning right onto Quail Home Road (18:30) then back to the Bourne Arms (18:45 / 19:00).
