After-School Club

From Monday 12th April, After-School Club hours will be extended to 5:30 pm (Monday-Thursday). If you need care up to 6:00 pm this can be arranged by pre-booking on Parent Pay. Friday will remain a short session to 4:30 pm. Ideally sessions need to be booked at least 2 days in advance to enable us to plan staffing.

Pre-School pupils can get free Breakfast and After School Care.

A timetable of activities and themed nights will be sent home next week.

Extra-Curricular Clubs

We are widening the range of clubs available for pupils after school. Some of these need to be kept to class bubbles at the moment but outdoor clubs can be more flexible. Please see the timetable for information – it will be sent out next week. More activities will be added. We will also be continuing with Maths intervention on Thursdays. (Wednesday for Maple Class).

Dance School Classes

Dance classes with Miss Gemma will continue in class bubbles next half-term. After that we are hoping to be able to mix groups and offer a wider range of dance genres. The cost will be £2 per class or £14 for 7 weeks starting week beginning 12th April – this can be paid on Parent Pay (See timetable next week for class times).

Many of our pupils have been dancing for a while now and we would like to see their skills. Over the holiday we would like to invite them to choreograph a short routine to a piece of music of their choice. The routine should be about one minute long.
