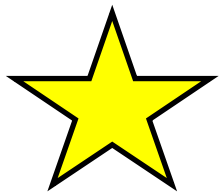
### **After-School Club**

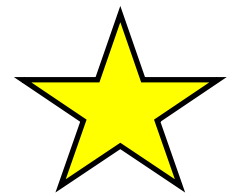
### **Earth Day**
