Covid Risk Management

All restrictions will remain in place next half-term although we will be making larger bubbles in school to allow 2 classes to mix at play-times and we will allow some mixing in extra-curricular clubs at the end of the day.

Please continue to wear face masks on the school site until further notice.

Uniform

Please can I ask that all pupils wear full school-uniform for school each day from the start of next half-term. Hair accessories should be red or white, earrings should be plain studs only, trainers may **NOT** be worn and neither should nail varnish or any other jewellery!

Last week, I said that pupils should go back to bringing PE kit in to change into but I have decided to continue to allow pupils to come to school in their PE kit on the class PE day. However, this **MUST** be a red PE t-shirt with black leggings, joggers or shorts and ideally black trainers or pumps. (Other plain trainers may be worn). A school sweatshirt or cardigan must be worn. Items of non-uniform will not be acceptable.

Dance kit should be brought into school **NOT** worn (see information on dance letter).
