### **Classes for next year**

I will send home a letter on Monday to let you know about our class structure for September. Year 3 will be split between Oak and Willow Class so parents of pupils who are currently in Year 2 will also be informed which class they will be in.

We have our Moving-Up Day on Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> July. To make things easier, all pupils apart from the current Year 6 can start school at 9:00 am and finish at 3:30 pm (just on Friday 2<sup>nd</sup>). Year 6 pupils with younger siblings in school may come in at 9:00 am otherwise they should arrive for 9:30 am dressed for a forest session.

I have recently appointed two new teachers who will be joining our staff team in September: Mrs Oxley and Miss Reeves. They will both be in school next Friday for Moving-Up Day

### **Breakfast/After-School Club**

If you need to drop pupils at school early (before 8:55 am) or you are late collecting, they will need to go into Breakfast or After-School Club and you will be asked to pay for a short session. This is to ensure pupils are safe and that there are adults available to care for them.

### **PE Kit**

Next year, we will continue to ask pupils to come dressed for PE on their class PE day. We are introducing PE hoodies which may be worn on PE day instead of their school sweatshirt or cardigan (not compulsory) with black leggings or joggers. These can be ordered on Parent Pay through July at £12.50 each.

### **Assessment Week**

Next week, all pupils in school will be undertaking assessments in English and Maths. This is just so we can get a measure of their progress since September and so the next class teacher knows what the starting point of each individual pupil will be. End of year reports will be coming home on Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> July which as well as general comments from the class teacher, will give detail on your child's attainment across the curriculum.

### **Dance Competition**

The winners of the competition to win dance kit are Holly Dyche and Lilly Madden—you can see their posters included in this newsletter. Well done to both of you!
