TERMS OF REFERENCE GOVERNORS' ETHOS COMMITTEE

Membership of the Committee: The Committee is to be made up of 5 members of the governing board, including the Headteacher, plus the Head Boy & Girl or their deputies.

Quorum: 3 governing board members of the committee.

Attendees: Other members of the school community may be invited to attend for specific reasons as deemed necessary by the committee membership

Meetings: The Committee will meet, at least, once a term. Meetings will be during the school day and will be minuted by one of the members and submitted to the full governing board.

Responsibilities: The main function of the Committee is to monitor and evaluate the school against the SIAMS standards and to contribute to establishing key priorities for the further development of the school as a church school.

Terms of Reference:

- To review the provision and development of collective worship.
- To review the provision and development of Religious Education.
- To review the development of the Christian distinctiveness of the school
- To monitor and take forward the SIAMS action plan.
- To contribute to the strategic planning processes of the school, including the setting of annual school priorities relating to the church school ethos.
- To support the development of pupil engagement. The Committee will hear regularly from the Head Boy and Head Girl as representatives of the pupils. A member of the Committee will be involved in the selection of the Head Boy and Head Girl.
