#### Booking/Payment:

When you email to book classes, an invoice will be sent out to you. Please pay for the half-term in the first week if possible. Payment should be made via BACS to school (details below) or you can send cash to school in a labelled envelope. Please let the school office know when you have paid, by email.

#### Clothes:

Pupils attending dance classes may bring kit to school in a bag. Dance kit is Laura Sandham top/t-shirt and leggings or school PE kit. Trainers or jazz shoes should be worn for Cheer or Street, Acro is bare feet. Pumps can be worn for dance and movement classes.

If you have ordered dance kit, this should be with us soon and we will send invoices out for payment.

If your child has a later dance class and you need them to stay in school, please contact the office about a discounted cost for a short After-School Club session. Alternatively, pupils can go home and come back for later classes.
