SPAR LANCASHIRE SCHOOL GAMES COMMONWEALTH GAMES 2022 SCHOOLS BATON RELAY

We are taking part in a very exciting opportunity which will bring together the schools and communities of Wyre through the exchanging of the **Spar Lancashire School Games Commonwealth Games Baton**. Much like the Olympic flame relay, the Spar Lancashire School Games baton will be making its way across Lancashire over the coming months to ultimately finish its journey at the Spar Lancashire School Games Day taking place at Blackpool Sports Centre on Tuesday 5th July. The baton will be passing through the Wyre area week commencing 20th June and will look to visit all the **GREAT ECCLESTON AND OVER WYRE Schools on MONDAY 20th JUNE**.

Two children from each class have been nominated to take part in this event. They will welcome the pupils from Stalmine School who are bringing the baton to us at 11:15am at the front entrance. School Trips/Experiences

Normally at this time of year, our classes would be going out of school on educational visits. The rising cost of coach transport has made this impossible as cost of transport alone for a trip to Blackpool would have been £13 per child before adding the cost of the venue.

We have found an alternative approach – having workshops come into school has proved successful this year. Our pupils still get the experience but for much less money. Next week, Oak and Willow Class have a Lego workshop linked to their topic on the Romans. This is a fabulous activity; Year 6 had a Lego workshop in the Autumn term linked to their Science topic on electricity and it has been identified as one of their highlights of the year.

Summer Fair

Thank you to everyone who supported the joint summer fair with St. Oswald's Church last Saturday. It was a lovely community event which we enjoyed being part of. Altogether it raised £1200 which has been split between church and school and will go to classes to spend on activities or resources.
