On Wednesday Mrs Adams and I went to help pack up the food boxes that the Preesall and Knott -End Volunteer Group provide to people in the local community who are in need. This group do an amazing job – they are supporting at least 30 families locally.

The children will walk back to school after the service so please make sure they are wearing a coat.

#### Life Education

#### Uniform


