Our three school rules are:

Be Kind

Be Respectful

Be Brave

In our school, we believe that everybody has a right to be treated equally and fairly. Children have the right to work, play and learn in a friendly, safe and supportive school environment. All children and adults in our school have the right to feel safe and happy

A **right to safety** means not just *being* safe but *feeling* safe in our school. Threatening behaviour, any type of violence or harassment, excluding others on purpose, bullying, name-calling and racism, are all behaviours that take away someone's right to feel safe and are unacceptable.

A **right to learn** means that we all have a responsibility to support our learning here by supporting other and co-operating with others. Distracting or disrupt others are behaviours that take away someone's right to learn and are unacceptable.

Our behaviour agreement is an important way to remind and help us to support these **rights and responsibilities**.

Children who are demonstrating our school rules by be rewarded with: • Class Dojo points • Certificates in celebration worship • Head teacher awards • A message home to parents • Time to show work to the Head teacher • Free time/Golden Time given in classrooms • Prizes • Treat days • Exciting learning opportunities!	If anyone in class makes it difficult for others to learn or feel safe then they may: • Be given a 'thinking time' card • Be moved in the classroom • Be asked to stay after the lesson and discuss their behaviour • Be given 'time-out' to calm down • Be asked to speak to another member of staff • Be asked to leave the class to go to isolation • Have their parents contacted to discuss behaviour • Be suspended

Here are some ways you can demonstrate our school rules:

Be Kind

- Help others when they need it
- Always include others
- Use kind words
- Use good manners
- Share with each other

Be Respectful

- Listen when people are talking (adults/peers)
- Look after school equipment
- Accept that we are all different and have our own unique light
- Treat others as you would like to be treated
- Move calmly and sensibly around school
- Show adults that you are ready to learn
- Be considerate of others and try to understand their feelings

Be Brave

- Try new things
- Persevere with difficult or challenging tasks
- Ask for help when we need it
- Stand up for what is right
- Challenge yourself
- Admit when you are wrong
- Tell the truth
- Contribute in class
