Free School Meals – Important Update

From September 2026, all children whose household receives Universal Credit will be entitled to Free School Meals, regardless of household income. This is a significant change and means many more families may now be eligible. If you receive Universal Credit, we encourage you to register your child, even if they have not qualified previously. This also applies to children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 who already receive Universal Infant Free School Meals.

Summer Holiday Clubs

A reminder that Sport First Coaching will once again be running sports and craft clubs throughout the summer holidays. Thanks to additional funding, the provision will run for the full five weeks. Children who are entitled to benefit-related Free School Meals can attend free of charge.
