Dear Parents

We are pleased to share with you, news about our upcoming residential trips for the current Y5 pupils. We have tried to give families as much notice as possible to ensure as many children as possible can attend.

Y5 Whitby

Mon 22nd – Wed 24th June 2026

Mon 29th -Wed 1st July 2026

Wed 1st July – Fri 3rd July 2026

We are excited to confirm that we have once again been able to secure a 2 night, 3 day stay at Enquire Learning Trust's residential centre in Whitby!

We are fortunate that once again Enquire Learning Trust have offered to cover the cost of the accommodation and excursions, so we are able to offer this for just £50.

Children will stay at our purpose built residential centre in Whitby. Here they will carry out a range of outdoor activities, such as rock pooling, fossil hunting, boat trips, walks, map skills, museums, field work, beach art, team building, history activities at Whitby Abbey and so much more! They will also be treated to a fish and chip tea and an incredible Ghost tour, designed with children in mind!

Your children will be really well looked after by the Whitby Team and will be accompanied by 5 members of staff from Flowery. All the activities have been planned and will be delivered by fully qualified teachers and are subject to thorough risk assessments.

The centre has 6 really comfortable children's rooms which are all en-suite, a kitchen and living area all furnished to the highest standard and an amazing custom-built fire pit area for all their toasted marshmallow needs! There is a huge range of evening activities on offer too and access to a huge range of equipment too! It really is a home from home and a phenomenal experience.

All meals are provided by our in-house catering team, with the exception of lunch on the first day, and we will work closely with you to ensure that all dietary requirements and allergies are taken into account.

We are asking for a £20 deposit to secure your child's place by the end of March, with the remaining £30 balance due by the end of May.

Y6 ROBINWOOD – Monday 25th to Wednesday 27th January 2027

This three day (two night) trip leaves school on the Monday morning, returning mid-afternoon of the Wednesday. We travel by coach to the Dobroyd Castle activity centre near Todmorden, where fully-trained staff run the fantastic range of activities on offer, allowing the children to 'face their fears' within a controlled, safe and supportive atmosphere.

It is not an exaggeration to say that you can literally see the children growing in confidence as the weekend unfolds.

Meals are provided and the centre provides all of the equipment that the children need; all that is required from you is that they come with 3 changes of 'old clothes', a towel and their night clothes.

We have been able to keep the cost at £200, despite the additional costs incurred by school. We understand this is still a lot of money so have split the cost across 10 monthly instalments of £20 from April-January. Unfortunately, the deposit of £20 is non refundable and needs to be paid by the end of April to secure your child's place..

We will be holding a parents' meeting on Tuesday 17th March to answer any questions you may have. This will take place straight after school and give you a chance to see some photos too!
