Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our ongoing work celebrating all the fantastic learning we have completed over the half term, we would like to invite you into our classrooms on **Thursday 16th April** to share our geography work.

The children will share all their learning with yourselves and perform some of the songs that have supported our work.

In addition, we wanted to inform you that, as part of the national curriculum, all children in Year 1 will take part in the **Phonics Screening Check** during the **week beginning Monday, 8th June 2026**. The Phonics Screening Check is a short, simple assessment that helps us confirm whether your child has learned to decode words using phonics to the expected standard.

To help you understand what the check involves and how you can support your child at home, we will be holding a **Parent Information Session** on the same day. During this session, we will explain the structure of the check, share examples of the types of words your child will be asked to read (including 'nonsense' or 'alien' words), and offer practical tips for phonics practice at home.

We strongly encourage all Year 1 parents and carers to attend, as your support makes a real difference in your child's learning journey. We will also hold a session later that same day for any parents who are unable to attend the earlier session. The running order of the day can be found as below:

Thursday 16th April

- 2:00PM: Phonics parent information session
- 2:30PM: Open classroom to share geography learning.
- 5:00PM: Phonics parent information session (for parents who cannot attend the earlier session).

A message will be sent out via Bromcom to help confirm a rough number of attendees. If you have any questions in the meantime, please don't hesitate to speak to your child's class teacher.
