Speech and Language Therapy (SALT)

Beth supports children who may need help with speaking clearly, understanding language, listening or expressing themselves. These skills are essential for learning, confidence and friendships.

Mental Health Support Team (MHST)

The team supports children's emotional wellbeing, including anxiety, low mood, friendships and managing emotions. Good mental health helps children feel happy, safe and ready to learn.
