Reception Baseline Assessments are conducted during the first 6 weeks of the school year.

KS2 SATs Week will be held in the week commencing **11th May 2026**. The whole school will be taking tests during this period.

Phonics Screening for Year 1 & Year 2 takes place from the **8th June 2026**. **Multiplication tables check for Year 4** takes place from **8th June 2026**.

It is very important that all children attend school during these periods of times.

DfE Guidelines mean that **NO** holiday requests will be authorised by school unless there are extremely special circumstances. When a pupil has at least 10 sessions of unauthorised absences from school, we have to notify the Local Authority and this may result in the issuing of a Penalty Notice fine.
