KS2 SATs Week will be held in the week commencing **11**th **May 2026**. The whole school will be taking tests during this period.

Phonics Screening for Year 1 & Year 2 takes place from the 8th June 2026. Multiplication tables check for Year 4 takes place from 8th June 2026.
