Dear Parents, Carers and Children,

Well, that's the first full week of the new school year completed! Hopefully, the vast majority of pupils (and staff!) are back into the routines of the school. Our new Year 3 pupils appear to have settled into junior school life and two of the three classes have 100% attendance!

We talk about attendance in school a great deal because it is a national concern and although we are very fortunate to have excellent attendance at FJS, building on the strong foundations established at the Infants, we will continue to celebrate success and challenge any issues. Four classes: 3KS, 3H, 5R and 6P have 100% attendance this week and overall the school attendance is 97.4%! This means that our School Council 'banks' £10 as a reward for hitting at least 97%. Last year, this resulted in £80 being spent on new playground equipment.
