$$4 \times 3 = 12$$

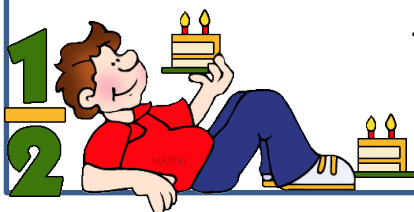
