<p><b>Home/School Diary</b></p>	<p>Children fill in their diary on a Friday with what is happening in the coming week.</p> <p>Parents/Carers should sign the diary to acknowledge that they have seen the schedule for the coming week.</p> <p>The home/school diary is a good way to communicate with the class teacher.</p> <p>Children bring their diary to school each day.</p> <p>Teachers check the diary on the following Monday and countersign it.</p> <p>Children should show their teacher if there is a message from home in their diary.</p> <p>At the end of the week children collect a ‘Smiley’ sticker as a reward for a successful week.</p>	
<p><b>Reading Book and Reading Record</b></p>	<p>Children should bring their reading book and reading record to school every day.</p> <p>Children are encouraged to keep a record of their reading in school.</p> <p>Parents/carers are encouraged to sign the reading record when children have read at home.</p>	

<b>Water Bottles and Snacks</b>	<p>All children should bring a bottle of water to school each day. The water fountains are currently switched off.</p> <p>Children who enjoy having a snack at break time are reminded to bring fruit.</p>
<b>Stationery</b>	<p>School will provide a pencil case for each child with all stationery that might be required. Children do not need to bring any stationery to school.</p>
<b>Coats</b>	<p>Children should have a coat each day – we will endeavour to have playtimes outside as much as possible even if it is drizzling.</p>
