On **Friday 15th December** we are inviting parents to come onto the playground at **2:30pm** to join everyone to sing Christmas Carols around the Christmas tree. We will ask parents to enter via the side gate by the hall and we will congregate on the Playpod Playground. This is a new event for this year and we are excited to be able to sing alongside parents.

Advent Reflections

We will soon be entering the period of Advent. We would, once again, like to recognise this important time in the Christian calendar by holding Advent Reflections. At this time of year, it is important for us all to take a moment and think about how important this time of year is.

The children in Prayer Council will lead each of the reflections. The reflections will have a different format to class assemblies and performances.
