At Forest & Sandridge we are allocated an amount of Sports Premium Funding. Below is a detailed account of how we spent it over the financial year 2018-19

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Key Spending Priorities for Sports Premium Funding in 2018-19

Total allocation: £19,250

The main objectives for use of Sports Premium Funding in 2018-19

- Provide high quality teaching and learning throughout the school
- Give equal opportunities for access to a range of sporting activities
- To increase the participation levels in sporting activities and provide opportunities for children regardless of ability
- To encourage SEND participation, with support where necessary
- Provide after school club which is focuses upon preparation for school competitive events run by PH Sports
- To provide access for all children to good quality organised sports activities during lunchtime
- Encourage an increased number of children to participate enthusiastically in a range of competitive inter-school sporting events and tournaments
- "Balancability" (Balance bikes and cycling) sessions for EYFS to improve cycle confidence and improve gross motor skills
- To introduce "Skills Force" (Duke of Cambridge Award Scheme) to give opportunities for children to enrich listening, communication and co-operative skills

Details of expenditure for 2018-19

Sports Coach

Sports Coach, (PH Sports), to provide weekly P.E. input with all classes. This will be high quality, specialised sports provision. Sports Coaches will be available during the day to support teachers in teaching of PE and school sports where needed. Teachers to develop teaching and learning skills and more accurate assessments. SEND children to be supported during sessions.

Cost: £4940

IMPACT: Quality sports provision has seen improved engagement of children during P.E. sessions. All children actively participating. Behaviour seen to be improved as a result of engagement. SEND children accessing P.E. curriculum through support within these sessions.

After school Sports Clubs

Enhancement of after school sports club provision. Making use of football and basketball dance coaches increasing numbers of children participating in competitive and non-competitive sports by choice. P.E. co-ordinator to oversee and promote this.

Cost: £832

IMPACT: Uptake of sporting clubs and activities remain high. A range of sporting opportunities offered. Sports coaching provided is of high quality. Sports offered provide equal-opportunities for all children to participate throughout the year. Success seen in football during the local Melksham School's tournament after which the higher ability children were entered into the West Wilts tournament. Also during gymnastics where the Year 3/4 team won the West Wilts Gymnastics competition.

Lunch Club Sports Coaching:

Daily lunchtime sports provision with qualified sports coach.

Cost: £4940

IMPACT: Children across the full age range have taken the opportunity to engage in structured and organised sporting activities. Fewer behaviour issues noted as particular children have chosen to become involved in sporting activities. Pupil voice discussions have indicated that children would like a time table of activities for each day of the week so that they know what is on offer. The location of this was moved onto the "Fast Playground" in order to give more room and to be more accessible to the Middle and Upper age range.

Skills Force

Duke of Cambridge Award Scheme to be introduced in year 4 with the aim of promoting listening, communication and co-operative skills. Children to engage in weekly sessions with instructor. Teachers to shadow the sessions to develop this further within class teaching.

Cost: £5000

IMPACT: Children are engaged in skill building sessions. Parental support has encouraged some successes through this programme. Communication and co-operative skills have been improved in general. Although we feel that children have benefitted overall from engagement in this scheme the impact has not matched up to costs. We have therefore decided not to continue with this next year.

"Balanceability" session: EYFS

Children in EYFS to participate in "Balanceability" sessions with instructor to promote cycling confidence and improve gross motor skills. SEND children to actively participate with support.

Cost: £1000

Impact: All EYFS children have been involved with sessions. Growth in confidence has been noted on a regular basis and as children learn new skills they have been regrouped accordingly.

Dance Festival

Preparation for Dance festival at The Forum, Bath. KS2 children to be offered an opportunity to attend an after school Dance club. Some transport costs and staff cover to be included.

Cost: £150

IMPACT: 30 children signed up to take part in this with several more on the waiting list (these will have first option in following year). Rehearsals were attended each week with only a couple of absences due to illness. All 30 children took part in a very successful Dance Festival.

Gymnastics

Year 5 children to utilise facilities and specialist coaching at The Wiltshire School of Gym, Melksham. Teachers to accompany classes to the gym to access equipment and apparatus and to work alongside gymnastics coaches. Children to be transported to the gym by bus and collected by parents. Teachers to assess and provide opportunities for ability groupings in order for children to attain at the highest level.

Cost: £750

IMPACT: High level of attainment noted by teachers. Children were re-grouped part way through the block of sessions to give higher attainers more challenging input. Pupil Voice discussions voted this a high-light of their year 5 P.E.

Swimming Gala

Forest and Sandridge School to contribute towards the local schools cluster Swimming Gala to be held at Melksham Blue Pool. Teacher to accompany children to the event.

Cost: £125

IMPACT: More able swimmers attend a high quality organised swimming event. Competitors achieve individual and team successes.

Resources and equipment

Sports equipment to be purchased as necessary during to year as identified by staff. A full and thorough audit will be carried out by the PE leader at this point in the year. Spending priorities will be identified.

Cost: £500

IMPACT: New items of equipment purchased and used by children to enhance learning. School sports strip replaced giving sense of pride and belonging for our team competitions.

Outdoor Learning

Equipment for outdoor and adventurous learning activities.

Cost: £500

IMPACT: All children across the school have access to high quality provision for outdoor learning activities. Staff leader has been able to purchase much needed equipment to enhance their learning.

Sundries

School Games Subscription

Cost: £150

IMPACT: Access to organised events in Melksham and West Wilts. Participation in sporting activities with other children at a higher level. Access to sports that we would not be able to access without this.

Forest and Sandridge School to contribute towards the local schools cluster Swimming Gala. Teacher to accompany children to the event.

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Approx cost: £500

Outdoor Gymnasium Equipment

To source and install fixed outdoor, all weather gymnasium equipment in order to provide a focus activity area for groups and lunchtimes. These will offer the children with a chance to engage in circuit training activities using well designed children's equipment. We aim to target children and groups in need of further physical exercise and for children to choose to use in their spare lunch and break times.

Approx Cost: £5000

School Games Subscription

Cost: £150

Long term plans to include an "All Weather Running Track" around the edge of the school field for greater access to the area all year round. This would have measured distances marked to encourage children to gauge how far they can run.
