**Uniform Policy**

Please find attached our updated Uniform Policy. We are aware at this time of year school uniform is probably becoming a little worn and wanted to give parents enough notice and avoid any expenditure that is not in line with our policy.

Please take some time to read through the policy carefully. We wanted to draw your attention to the following details which you will find within the updated uniform policy:

- Plain black school shoes (No open-toed shoes or sandals, trainers or canvas shoes). Children may wear plain black ankle boots. **Black trainers are not school uniform.**
- Plain green, black, grey, or white tights OR plain white, grey, or black socks (socks or tights must be worn). Sport socks with logos are not school uniform
- Hair accessories should be in keeping with school uniform: green, black, or white (novelty alicebands, including alicebands with ears and oversized bows are not allowed).
- Children should not wear jewellery to school other than a cheap watch or stud earrings. **Smart watches are not allowed in school.**
- Outlandish hairstyles, coloured hair, nail varnish, fake nails and makeup are not allowed in school. If a child comes to school with nail varnish, fake nails or make up on, parents will be contacted and asked to make arrangements for it to be removed.

**We expect all uniform to be named.**

At Forest & Sandridge, we are proud of our school and we are proud to represent it. By wearing school uniform, the children gain a strong sense of identity and can share in this pride. We expect all children to adhere closely to our uniform policy and will follow up with parents when children are not wearing uniform. Thank you for your co-operation.
